Position Title:	Water Resource Technician
Position Location:	North Branch, MN
Classification:	Full Time, Temporary
Compensation Rate:	\$13.00- \$15.00 per hour, depending on qualifications and experience

Duration:	Up to 6 months, late April – November with possible extension dependent on future funding.

Minimum Qualifications: A Bachelors degree with a major field of study in the natural resources field focused on the restoration of native vegetation is desired. Experience in selecting appropriate native aquatic and terrestrial species to restore areas is a benefit. This position requires a valid driver's license and good driving record. Other strongly desired qualifications include: proficiency using MS office computer software, GPS and ArcView GIS software.

Responsibilities: The primary objective of this position is to provide technical assistance to the residents of Chisago County with the design and installation of streambank and shoreline restoration projects, rain gardens, and general backyard conservation planning. A majority of work activities will be outside field work with some office work designing projects. The Technician works under the supervision of the District Administrator.
